

Map Information Service

If requested, the County of Santa Cruz will provide you with the following information upon request:

- Whether a property is in or out of the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) of the County.
- Additional flood insurance data for a site, such as the FIRM zone and the base flood elevation or depth, if shown on the FIRM.
- Information about the flood insurance purchase requirement that can help people who need a mortgage or loan for a property in the SFHA.
- If filed with the County, a copy of an existing elevation certificate. The County of Santa Cruz maintains elevation certificates for new and substantially improved structures in the SFHA since January 1, 1987.

If you would like to obtain this service, please visit the Planning Department during business hours and speak with Resource Planning staff. The cost for this service is \$91.80.

Please note: The County of Santa Cruz updates the Flood Insurance Rate Maps as needed when revisions are made to the maps.
